

Notice Board Widget Enhancements

Overview

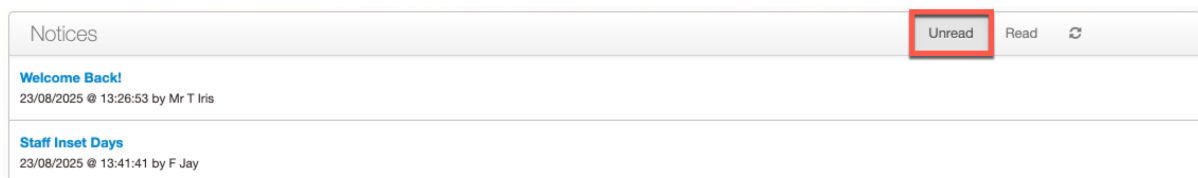
Based on customer feedback, the Notice Board widget has been enhanced to improve both user experience and admin management of notice board entries.

The update introduces three new tabs:

- **Unread** – Displays all notice board entries that the user has not yet read. (Default tab for users)
- **Read** – Displays all entries the user has already read.
- **Expired** – Visible only to admins; shows all notice board entries that have expired.

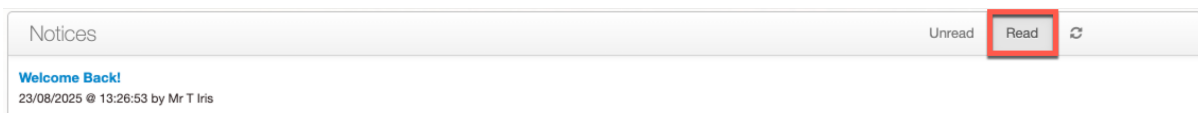
By default, users will land on the **Unread** tab when accessing the widget, helping ensure important updates are not missed.

Example of a teacher view with the **Unread** tab selected:



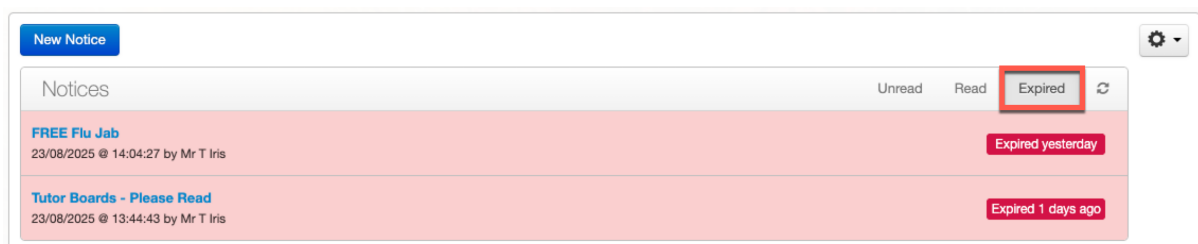
Once a user selects a notice board entry to view its details and then navigates back, the entry will automatically move to the **Read** tab.

Example of a teacher view with the **Read** tab selected:



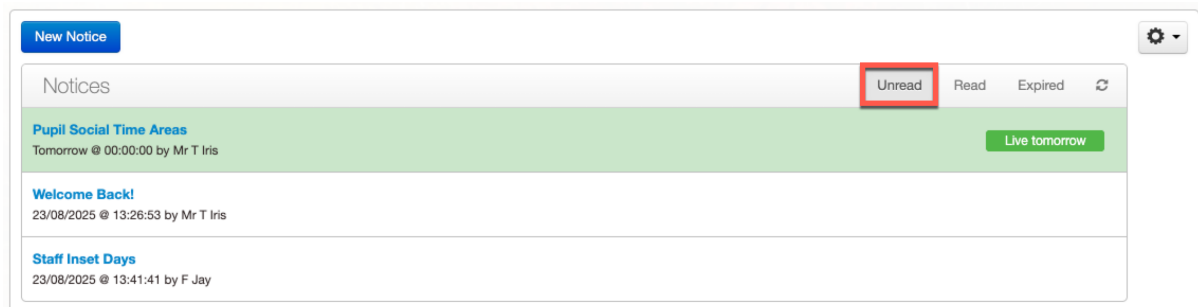
Admins have access to an additional tab, **Expired**, within the Notice Board widget. This tab displays all notice board entries that have passed their expiry date.

Example of an admin view with the **Expired** tab selected:



When an admin selects either the **Unread** or **Read** tabs, they will also see any notice board entries that are scheduled to be displayed in the future.

NOTE - If the Notice Board widget is set to “Show Detail of the entry,” users must still click on the message for it to be marked as read and moved from the Unread tab to the Read tab.
