

## Bugs Resolved – Hopper v2606\_0\_2

Below are the bugs resolved in the Hopper release (v2606\_0\_2) and the update to the central FrogPlay quiz services (v13.3.49), released on Wednesday 24th June 2026.

### FrogDrive > Google Drive

- **JIRA# SA-1452** – Due to changes implemented by Google, for schools using the Google Drive integration within Frog, the preview modal that was previously displayed has been removed. Instead, documents accessed via the integration will now open in a new browser tab.

This change affects access to Google linked documents in the following areas:

- FrogDrive > My Documents
- FrogDrive > Google Drive
- Timeline (when a Google Document has been created via My Documents)

**Note** – No changes have been applied to the following widgets:


- Google Activity widget
- Google Preview widget

### Forms

- **JIRA# MEGA-459** – When a form is placed on a site and a user only has “Can View” access to that site, an information message will now be shown at the bottom of the form, advising that they do not have permission to complete it. The “Submit” button will also be disabled.

The message shown to users is:

**You do not have permission to complete this form.**

## Groups and Policies Application

- **JIRA# SA-1393** - Within Groups and Policies, a new role has been introduced for the Messages application:

Messages > Chat is enabled

By default, this role is enabled for all user profiles (admin, staff, student, parent).

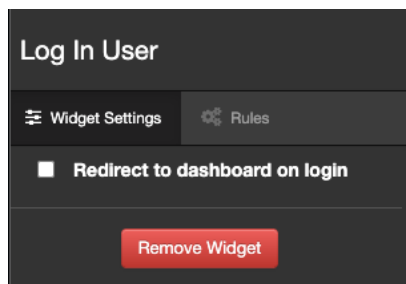
The introduction of this role allows schools to control whether the Chat feature within the Messages application is available. If this role is set to OFF, the Chat feature will be disabled for the relevant users. This setting is also respected within the Frog GO mobile application, where Chat will no longer be displayed on the landing page for those users.

## Login In User Widget

- **JIRA# STAB-4275 / MEGA-365** – When the Log In User widget is placed on a site, a new option called “Redirect to dashboard on login” is now available within the widget settings.

Previously, if a user selected this widget on a public site and then logged in, the site they were viewing would remain open after authentication, requiring them to close it to access their dashboard.

When the “Redirect to dashboard on login” option is enabled, users will instead be taken directly to their dashboard after logging in, rather than returning to the public site.



## Markbook

- **JIRA# STAB-4278 / MEGA-370** – When attaching resources to an assignment, the maximum allowed file name length has been increased to 500 characters.

## Profile Menu > My Preferences > Notifications

- **JIRA# STAB-3972 / MEGA-367** – When Noticeboard email notifications are enabled, the date and time displayed within notification emails will now be converted to the recipient’s local time zone. Previously, all times were displayed in UTC, regardless of the recipient’s location.

## Quizzes

- **JIRA# IALSTAB-1236** – Resolved an issue where long question text used within the Fill the Blanks (Dropdown) question type did not display correctly. Question text will now wrap correctly and be displayed as expected to users.
- **JIRA# IALSTAB-1232 / STAB-4270** – Resolved an issue where, if a site containing a quiz was duplicated and the Quiz widget was subsequently updated to use a different quiz, the Class Reports area could still display data relating to the original quiz. Class Reports will now correctly display data only for the quiz currently linked to the site.

## Reporting Application

- **JIRA# STAB-4257 / MEGA-350** – A new report parameter, “Reporting Period Range”, has been added to the Progress Coverage Summary > Students vs Time – Graph report, with the following options:
  - **Up to selected reporting period** – Includes all data up to and including the selected assessment cycle/period. This reflects the report’s previous behaviour.
  - **From selected reporting period onwards** – Includes all data from the selected assessment cycle/period onwards.

## Sites

- **JIRA# STAB-4295 / MEGA-364** – Resolved an issue where, when the Crystal theme was used on a site containing a large amount of content, some content was cut off and not displayed correctly.
- **JIRA# STAB-4246 / MEGA-456** – Updated the “Aurora” theme set so that, when a site is viewed on a mobile device, sub-menus are now responsive and page content loads as expected.

This issue only appeared to affect sites using an “Aurora” theme when viewed on an iOS device.

- **JIRA# MEGA-334** – Sites have been improved so that, when a site contains multiple levels of navigation, users are automatically directed to the first page in the hierarchy that contains content. This means that if the top-level page and one or more sub-pages contain no content, users will be taken directly to the first sub-page that does.

This applies when sites are viewed by logged-in users, as well as when sites are shared as “Public on the web”. This change helps improve site navigation and avoids users landing on pages that contain no content.

Please note that this change does not apply when a site is set to “Presentation” mode.
