Sites - Sharing Improvements


Overview

We've introduced an enhancement to the Sites feature, specifically focusing on sharing capabilities. This update enables teachers to quickly and easily share Sites and resources directly with students and parents in a particular class.

This improvement streamlines the workflow for teachers, allowing them to efficiently keep parents informed about class information, content, and learning resources.


How-to

Navigate to a site you have previously created or create a new site. The process to share a site is no different, whereby you will need to navigate to the **Frog Bar** > **Share** > **Share** > **Next** and will see the pop-up window that allows you to set who the site is to be shared with and permissions.




A site can be shared to individuals or groups. To showcase the site sharing enhancements, we are going to focus on sharing to a registration group.

Within the **Who has access** field, enter in a few characters of your class name and the system will display any groups matching your search criteria. In this example we searched for **reg** to have a list of groups matching the criteria displayed for selection.




The group **Reg 5a** has been selected and added to the share list. You'll notice a new group setting available, which is set to **All Group Members** by default.




If we select the arrow next to All Group Members, the following options are available:

- All Group Members Site will only be shared to individuals associated with the selected group.
- Students Site will only be shared with students associated with the selected group.
- **Staff** Site will only be shared with staff associated with the selected group.
- Parent/Carer of Student Members Site will only be shared with the associated parents/carers of the students associated with the selected group.


• Students and Parent/Carer of Student Members - Site will only be shared with students associated with the selected group as well as the associated parents/carers of the students associated with the selected group.



In this example we would like to share the site **Class 5** with the students as well as their parent/carers of **Reg 5a**. Therefore, we will select the option **Students and Parent/Carer of Student Members**.



The last step is to set what permissions you would like users to have to the site. If you have content that requires interaction with the users, such as Wall, Notice Board, Timelines, you will want to set the permission to be **Can Contribute**.



When happy with all your changes select the **Share** button. The site will be made available immediately to the appropriate users as per sharing permissions configured.

When the site is initially shared an event will appear on the user's timeline.

Below is an example of what the timeline event will look like for a student, **James Wilson**, who is a member of the group **Reg 5a**.



Additional Information

Post the initial sharing of your site, when a new user is subsequently added to a group, the sharing rules are automatically applied. However, the user won't have a timeline notification display.
