Completing a Quiz

When you have been assigned work by a teacher, you will receive a notification which can be accessed in the MyFrog Notifications menu here.

Alternatively, you may have a homework calendar on your school's Frog dashboard which will display this work.

This is an example of the homework calendar in case you're not familiar with it at this point.

I can see my homework for next week and I can see I have been set a Maths quiz. Double-clicking on the homework tile will take me to the homework itself.

Here, I can see a bit more information, including the quiz, which I can access using the Launch Quiz button.

If your school has FrogPlay and if your teacher has allowed it for this quiz, you may have the chance now to select a game to play during the quiz, or you can select Quick Fire to get straight into the questions.

If you don't have FrogPlay, then you'll get straight to the quiz from the Launch Quiz button.

So I'm inside the quiz now and it's worth noting there are a few options in the top right-hand corner of this window. You can increase or decrease the font size, expand the quiz to a full screen and choose whether you want to turn on accessibility mode or not.

In a quiz, you will be presented with different types of questions that require different actions so make sure you read each question properly.

Usually you will just be selecting an answer like this one but sometimes you may have to put things in order, fill in missing text or type an answer.

In this example, I need to select one of the answers and click submit to lock my answer in the quiz.

If I was unsure about this answer, I could skip it and come back to it later by clicking on the Skip button here.

Clicking Finish at any point gives you an overview on all the questions you have or haven't answered.

You can click on any question and it will take you back to that question in the quiz.

After clicking the Finish button there is an option in this window to exit the quiz. At this point you have three options:

- You can either pause the quiz, which will save where you're up to and you can revisit it later.
- You can select cancel which will return you to the quiz
- The final option is that you can hand-in your answers. You should only hand-in your work when you are happy you have completed the task as you cannot go back in and retry the quiz once this has been selected.

When you have handed your quiz in, you will be taken back to the assignment page. If there were more activities, you can then attempt these now but in this example, there was only a quiz, so I'll click on the hand-in assignment button in the bottom right hand corner. You need to ensure you submit your work AND hand-in your assignment when you're ready to.

If your school does have FrogPlay, they will have set up a page where you can see other quizzes. If you complete these quizzes on your own, you'll earn credits, which you can use to unlock more games or buy parts for your avatar. You can earn more credits depending on how well you do in a quiz, more if you choose English or Maths and yet more credits if you choose to play quizzes on a Sunday.

There are also two-player games in FrogPlay. You can select a quiz then a 2-player game and then invite a friend to join and play against you.

Lots of English and Maths quizzes have video tutorials too, so if you get stuck, you can get instant help.
